## Charges:

- 1. Review existing NRC, EPA, DOE and CRCPD Suggested State Regulations for Control of Radioactive Materials.
- 2. Review existing CRCPD and industrial (e.g., ISRI) Guidance for response to discovered orphan sources.
- 3. Review DOT, NRC, EPA, DHS, IAEA and other protocols for response to orphan sources and radioactive commodities.
- 4. Determine essential radiological controls needed to protect the public, workers and environment during the immediate response to orphan sources and radioactive commodities discovered in commerce and/or at the entry to U.S. borders.
- 5. Determine appropriate domestic and international notifications and timelines for such discoveries.
- 6. To ensure environmental protection and public health and safety, develop a protocol for use by the federal government and states when responding to orphan sources and radioactive commodities discovered in commerce and/or at the entry to U.S. borders.
