**E-48 Task Force to Develop Best Practices for use of DOT Special Permits****Charges:**

1. Develop a “Best Practices” document for the use of DOT Special Permits by state radiation control programs and by scrap and waste facilities.
2. Coordinate with the E-34 Committee on a review of DOT Special Permit forms DOT-SP 10656 and DOT-SP 11406 for potential revisions.
3. Complete the “Best Practices” document and review of DOT Special Permit forms by December 31, 2022.
4. Coordinate with the E-34 Committee to develop an online training module on the proper use of DOT Special Permits for members to access at any time.
5. Offer an in-person training session or poster for the 2023 CRCPD annual meeting.
