## Charges:

- 1. To periodically review and comment as needed on the IEC standards and other proposed standards or guidance change as related to healing arts.
- 2. To review any applicable guidance and or training material from FDA or other federal agencies regarding the use of the IEC or any other proposed standards relating to healing arts and provide comments as needed.
- 3. To update the board and the state program directors for issues regarding any new standards and guidance pertaining to healing arts as it affects state programs.
- 4. To work with IAEA, CDC, MITA, AAPM, ACR and other groups on healing arts standards and guidance on behalf of CRCPD.
- 5. To develop guidelines for the regulatory authority on the authorization and inspection of new radiation sources/devices used in medicine including characteristics, use, risks and hazards, compliance with FDA in description and use and any applicable IEC standards.
- 6. To provide outreach regarding new standards and guidance via website, position statements and Newsbrief articles.
