EXECUTIVE BOARD**

POSITION

The Executive Board of the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc. (CRCPD), at their Fall meeting in 1991, adopted the following position relating to indoor radon:

It is the formal position of the CRCPD that indoor radon is a significant public health risk, and the main burden of implementing indoor radon public information and the encouragement of abatement is ultimately a State responsibility. The CRCPD has actively encouraged and supported the State grant program which is currently authorized under the Indoor Radon Abatement Act.

It is the position of the Executive Board of the CRCPD that the State Indoor Radon Grant Program be extended beyond its original three-year authorization so as to provide states adequate time to develop sufficient programs.

The immediate re-authorization of the State Radon Grant Program is essential to the continuing viability and effectiveness of State radon programs and the national goal of significantly reducing indoor radon exposure.
