RESOLUTION VI

Relating to: Task Forces and Committees

WHEREAS: The Task Forces and Committees of the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors, Inc., have been the backbone of the Conference, contributing to the control of radiation in the United States of America and internationally; and

WHEREAS: There has been a lack of support, direction, and encouragement provided to the activities of the Task Forces and Committees by the Executive Board in the recent past; and

WHEREAS: The Task Forces and Committees represent the only source of input into the decisions, policies, goals, and objectives of the Conference; and

WHEREAS: The Task Forces and Committees represent the only means of encouraging new and younger persons in the Conference's membership to actively participate in the Conference activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

By the Membership of the Conference in Annual Meeting convened, that the Executive Board be instructed to:

- 1. Prepare or cause the preparation of a Task Force and Committee Operation Handbook and publish and distribute it to the membership not later than October 1 of each year,
- 2. So manage the monies of the Conference that no less than 50% of all Conference monies is spent directly on Task Force and Committee activities.
- 3. Annually review the purpose, charge, and progress made toward completion of the charge of each Task Force and Committee and eliminate those which have completed their charge or which have not made significant progress,

4. Reinstitute the report of individual Task Forces and Committees on the agenda of the Annual Meetings, and

5. Encourage and support the Task Forces and Committees in their work by active involvement and outward display of interest.
