### SR-N Suggested Regulations - Part N: TENORM Rules

#### Charges:

##### 1<sup>st</sup> Phase – Data Scoping:

- Compile and examine any rulemaking efforts since 2004. New issues identified or potential areas of conflict with the current SR-N will be documented.
- Establish and Review a Listing of technical and policy-oriented publications from applicable bodies since the publication of SSR-N. Identify areas requiring regulatory address or potential conflict.
- Establish and Review a Listing of industrial technologies and source terms that have emerged since the publication of SSR-N and require consideration in the review of SSR-N.

##### 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase – Review of SR-N:

- Determine if a general trend or need exists in the rulemaking efforts across the nation and internationally.
- Determine if revisions in current SR-N are necessary to incorporate the recommendations and needed aspects of any publication that are deemed pertinent by the working group.
- Determine if the current SR-N is inclusive of new technologies and source terms brought about by technological and industrial advances since the last publication of SSR-N.
- Determine if the current format of SSR-N can accommodate any recommended changes through an update or if a rewrite is necessary.
- Update the Board Chairperson and request an update of the working group change as necessary.

Note: When a Letter/Number combination appears in brackets after a charge, it denotes how the charge links to CRCPD's Goals and Objectives, as listed in [CRCPD's Strategic Plan](#).
