SR-R Suggested Regulations – Part R: Radon**Charges:**

1. Revise Part R as needed to include to keep it current with standards of practice for:
 - a) Elements of QA/ QC program for an appendix
 - b) Requirements for commercial calibration facilities
 - c) New building construction
 - d) Real estate
 - e) Framework for potential reciprocity among states [G1 - O4]
2. Review and develop CRCPD comments on any proposed federal regulations pertaining to requirements for radon measurement and mitigation certification or credentialing. [G1 – O3]
3. Review and develop CRCPD comments on any national consensus standards pertaining to radon. [G1 – O3]
